Training venue & schedule

The LOC will organise training sessions in both the main competition venue starting on March 16th, 2023 Pozuelo Bay located 3km from the Village as per schedule below:

Training at the Competition Venue in Lake Pozuelo

AM: 08:00 - 11:00 PM: 13:00 - 16:00

Training at Swimming Pool Albergue Olímpico

AM: 06:00 - 08:00 09:00 - 11:00 PM: 15:30 - 18:00





IMPORTANT: For all those teams arriving earlier March 16th, 2023, the OC will provide training options under previous request (main venue and/or pool). Therefore, if your team is planning to arrive earlier than the March 16th, 2023, please contact the OC with your training plans and request so they can organise the training accordingly.

Technical Meeting

The technical meeting will take place at Albergue Olimpico on March 17 at 9:00 AM. The meeting will be open to everyone with appropriate accreditation for the Open Water swimming event. Athletes must attend in order to validate their participation in the events.

The PanAm Aquatics Open Water Swimming Committee Chairperson will lead the meeting, which will be conducted in English and, if required, with translation in Spanish.

Competition Venue

The competition of 5km, 7.5km and 10km swim will be organised on a 1,250m lap course (left shoulder turns). Swimmers must swim eight (8) laps for 10km, and four (4) laps for 5km. 4 x 2.5km mixed relay will be on a 2,500m lap course, left shoulder turn. Course design for the above races attached. Details of the final course will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

Current and Weather Information

The climate comfortable there the month of march. The high seasonal norm is 83°F. In the morning the temperature drops to 76°F. Thus, the mean temperature average in March in Guayama is 79°F. Note that these seasonal averages are in contrast with those observed in Guayama in March with a maximum record of 90°F in 2017 and a minimum record of 70°F in 2010.

Day length in Guayama in March is 12:02. The sun rises at 10:32 and sunset is at 22:34.

Entry Information

The PanAm Open Water Series are open to entries from competitors in good standing with their National Federations who are members of PanAm Aquatics or of invited WA member Federations.

• The competitor must be a citizen, whether through birth or naturalization, of the country being represented, according to the GR-2.5 Rule of WA.

Awards

First, Second and Third place medals will be given for each event. Team High point awards will be given for 14-17 and 18+ (Men, Women and Combined).

Points scored will be awarded in the following order: **20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1**

Points scored will count towards the PanAm Aquatics Open Water Series Financial Bonus awarded at the end of the 2023 Series.

Technical Equipment

Hy-Tek Meet Manager will be used for registration and competition results. Timing will be done using Time Machine.

Clothing and Equipment

Swimwear Protocol: Swimwear worn shall be according to WA by-laws BL 7 and BL 8.

Anti-Doping

During the competition, anti-doping control tests may be conducted, according to the control rules established by World Aquatics (FINA).

Protests

Protests will be resolved under WA Rule GR 9.2.

Protests must be submitted to the Chief Referee in writing by the team leader, with a deposit of US\$100, within 30 minutes following the conclusion of the respective event.

All protests will be considered by the Chief Referee.

The commission (including the PAQ President or her representative, the PAQ OW Chair and the PAQ OW Commission members) present at the event will consider appeals against decisions by the Chief Referee and give recommendations to the jury of appeal, whose decision will be final.





Jury of Appeal

For the Series, the jury of appeal shall consist of a minimum of three persons and will be comprised of the PanAm Aquatics Executive Committee and PanAm Aquatics Honorary Members present and the WA Delegate (if present) with the PAQ President or in his or her absence a PAQ Vice-President and/or PAQ Executive Liaison for Open Water Swimming as chairman.

A jury member will be allowed to speak, but not to vote, on a case in which the interest of his/her PAQ Federation is involved. Technical Officials and Judges for Open Water Swimming shall not be entitled to form part of the jury.

In case of urgency, the jury may vote on a matter even if it has not been possible to contact all members.

The decision of the jury will be final.

Technical Officials

WA certified officials including Referees, Timekeepers, Finish judges, Course and safety officers, race/turn judges, starters, recorders will be running this event.

Registration

Each national federation must complete their registrations before the designated deadlines. In the interests of providing the Organizing Committee with optimal time to make hotel, meal, transportation, and other logistical arrangements, please submit your registration at your earliest convenience.

Entries will be accepted until midnight on February 20, 2023

Accreditation

The Organizing Committee will provide all Swimmers and Team Staff with an official Accreditation card. Only accredited people will be allowed to access certain venue areas. All accredited people are requested to carry their Accreditation Cards with them at all times and to show them upon request. Team managers will be required to present photographic identification for all team members in order to collect the Accreditation cards.
