ACCOMMODATION

Location

The Villa at the Albergue Olímpico, at the Albergue Olímpico Germán Rieckehoff, Salinas Puerto Rico.



Special Rate is \$120.00 per person, per night and includes the following:

- Accommodation at the Villa (5 nights and 6 days or 6 nights and 7 days).
- Transportation (round-trip airport transfers, to all competition transfers, and special activities).
- Three meals daily (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) starting with dinner on April 30th and ending with breakfast on the departure day.

Reservation

A 50% initial payment is required for booking and must be made on or before April 15th, 2024. The remaining balance must be completed upon arrival at The Villa. Failure to make the 1st instalment payment by the specified date may result in the inability to guarantee the stay and/or accommodation offer (limited spaces).



REGISTRATION

Swimmers must be duly federated and eligible to compete.

Results can be viewed through the Meet Mobile application on your mobile device and officially through Meet Manager.

The registration fee is \$50.00 per swimmer. Registration and fee payment must be completed on or before April 15th, 2024.

All swimmers and team personnel will receive an official accreditation card:

- Accreditation is required to access certain areas of the venue.
- Delegates and/or coaches of the teams are required to present photo identification to collect their delegation's accreditation cards at the technical meeting.

Protests

The Discipline Committee is designated to receive the official delegate accredited by the delegation. The protest must be in writing and accompanied by a fifty-dollar (\$50) fee. The claim must be made up to 30 minutes prior to the situation to be adequately addressed.

4 Puerto Rican officials duly certified by the "World Aquatics" and trained national officials will be in designated areas.

WATER AND LAND SAFETY
